Promotion and Public Relations Funds

The Superintendent may establish an account in the District budget to be used for public relations and promotion that will directly benefit or be in the best interest of the District. Revenue for this purpose shall consist of a portion of the funds accruing to the Board from auxiliary enterprises and undesignated gifts. No public tax funds may be used for this purpose.

- (1) District Representatives designated by the Superintendent or designee(s) may be reimbursed from this fund for approved expenses incurred in the conduct of official duties while representing the District.
- (2) All expenditures from this account shall be in accordance with law and State Board of Education Rules.
- (3) Expenditures shall be based on written requests for reimbursement and supported by receipts.
- (4) Disbursements for any fiscal year may not exceed the amount authorized for such funds as prescribed by rules of the State Board of Education.
