Monitoring Safety and Security of District Facilities

The School Board shall ensure adequate safety and security monitoring processes and systems for all District facilities.

- (1) All District facilities shall be monitored electronically as required by federal, state or local regulations. Additional electronic monitoring may be placed at facilities and/or school buses if needed. Personnel may also be employed where appropriate to ensure adequate monitoring and safety of students, employees, community members or facilities. The Department of School Support shall be responsible for obtaining appropriate monitoring equipment and/or personnel as recommended by safety committees and/or through safety and security audits.
- (2) The Safety, Security and Inspections Department shall be responsible for developing and implementing the District's Five, Ten, and Twenty-Year Security Plan as well as assisting all facility administrators with their site-based security plans.
- (3) No Monitoring equipment shall be purchased (for any school bus or district owned/leased property) without first contacting the supervisor of Security Surveillance Department to insure compatibility of all electronic equipment.
