Scope of the School District

The School Board of Lee County is the governing body of The School District of Lee County and is responsible for the control, operation, organization, management, and administration of public schools in the County pursuant to the provisions and minimum standards prescribed by Florida Statutes and State Board of Education rules.

The School District of Lee County is part of the State system of public education and includes all public schools:

- Grades PK-12
- Adult and general education
- Exceptional student education
- Dual enrollment, job entry, and vocational education classes
- Courses of instruction
- All services and activities directly related to education in the District, which are under the District school officials' direction.
