Academic Standards

The School Board of Lee County is committed to high academic standards for all students.

- (1) The School District of Lee County’s vision, goals and priorities shape the academic standards that the School Board establishes in alignment with the Florida Sunshine State Standards. In Lee County, academic standards shall:
 - (a) Set high requirements for basic skills, problem solving and conceptual thinking for all students.
 - (b) Establish clear learning targets that all students can achieve.
 - (c) Provide information to students about the skills, the knowledge and the quality of work needed to meet or exceed each standard.
 - (d) Define for teachers what students should know and be able to do at each grade and course.
- (2) There are two levels of standards: “meets” and “exceeds.”
 - (a) “Meets” level is the rigorous academic standard.
 - (b) “Exceeds” level is a measure of excellence beyond what is required.
