Curriculum

The adopted curriculum of the School District of Lee County shall be based on the Florida Sunshine State Standards and shall reflect the District's vision, goals and priorities. These standards include subject area content as well as the State's Next Generation Standards.

In order to reflect the priorities of the community, the process for curriculum review and evaluation shall include participation from teachers, administrators, students, families and community members. The process for selection and evaluation of instructional materials shall include similar participation.

The Board affirms that the curriculum shall:

- (1) Clearly identify, highlight and require integrated thinking within and across the disciplines.
- (2) Provide for systematic and developmental methods for building understanding as well as content knowledge and recall.
- (3) Identify performance levels as well as key skills.
- (4) Accommodate student diversity.

At the secondary level, the curriculum shall provide well-articulated courses of study that prepare students for post-secondary opportunities and skills necessary for employment.
