### Student Discipline

Each student enrolled in the School District shall be under the control and direction of the principal or administrative designee. The principal and staff shall be responsible for the following:

(1) Principal

- (a) A school discipline plan for the control and direction of students in order to maintain a safe and orderly environment that is consistent with the Board approved Code of Conduct for Students.
- (b) An annual review of the school discipline plan.
- (c) A plan to review the Code of Conduct for Students and all policies relating to student behavior at the beginning of the school year at School Advisory Council meetings, Parent Teacher Association Organization meetings and at appropriate times throughout the school year with each student.

(2) Staff

- (a) Each staff member shall have the obligation to assume authority for the control of students as assigned by the principal or designee.
- (b) The staff's responsibility for control and direction of students shall be exercised throughout the campus of each school and is not limited to a specific group of students.
