Permission to Leave School Campus

The principal of each school shall be responsible for determining when a student may leave campus. The principal or designee shall enforce the following rules:

- (1) No student shall be sent from the campus to perform errands or serve as a messenger without the approval of the principal and consent of a parent/guardian.
- (2) The principal or designee shall establish the identity and authority of any person who requests the release of a student from school.
- (3) The principal or designee shall not release a student to anyone other than the parent/guardian having legal custody of the student, without the verified authorization of the parent/guardian who has legal custody of the student.
- (4) These rules shall not apply to law enforcement officers, court officials, or proper District employees, provided that the person's identity and authority are clearly established.
