Responsibility of Students and Parents/Guardians for Instructional Materials

The following rules and responsibilities apply to a student and a parent/guardian regarding instructional materials on loan from the District:

- (1) All instructional materials purchased under the provisions of chapter 1006.42, F.S. shall be the property of the District.
- (2) Instructional materials distributed to students shall be loaned to the students and are to be returned at the direction of the principal or designee.
- (3) Each parent/guardian of a student to whom materials have been issued shall be held liable for any loss or destruction of or damage to such materials or for the failure of the student to return the materials when directed to by the principal or designee.
- (4) If a student fails to pay any fee assessed due to loss of damage of School District materials, diplomas or report cards shall not be withheld as long as appropriate performance standards prescribed by the State and District have been met. However, students may be prohibited from participating in extracurricular activities or required to perform community service activities at the school as determined by the principal.
