Distribution of Handouts by Students

Any student wishing to distribute materials to other students on a school campus during or after the school day must follow the following process.

- (1) Any student desiring to distribute handouts at school must submit the materials to the Superintendent for review before distribution.
- (2) The Superintendent or his/her designee will notify the student of his decision within seven (7) calendar days.
- (3) The Superintendent or his/her designee shall apply the following standards when considering approval:
 - (a) No handout may be obscene or promote products or services, which minors may not legally purchase or use.
 - (b) No handout may contain libelous material.
 - (c) No handout shall be proselytizing.
 - (d) No handout may be approved which would tend to create a substantial disruption in the school environment.
- (4) If handouts are approved for distribution, the school principal may establish the time and location the distribution will occur.
- (5) All handouts shall contain the following disclaimer in **bold** print:

The school is neither endorsing nor sponsoring this event, product or service nor endorsing the views of the sponsoring organization.
