Multi-Zone School Admissions

The following procedures shall be followed for multi-zone school admissions:

- (1) Selected schools within the District may be designated by the School Board to provide a program or curriculum that is not available in every School Choice Zone. The cost of providing the program or the specific criteria or curricular requirements makes these programs difficult to provide in each zone.
- (2) The opportunity to enroll in these schools is extended to students in two or three zones.
- (3) Each year, District staff shall update the listing of multi-zone admission schools. After the listing has been approved by the School Board, the listing shall be made available through published Student Assignment materials and at the Student Assignment Office.
- (4) Students may inquire about admittance into each of these schools through the Student Assignment Office. Students shall be selected for assignment to these schools based on the Student Assignment procedures or by using procedures and admissions criteria specific to the school or program.
- (5) Transportation shall be provided for all eligible students selected to attend a multi-zone school.
- (6) Any high school student assigned to a zone school that moves out of a zone may be granted a waiver to remain at the school if the student has completed at least four semesters at the school. The student must provide their own transportation to and from school or they may access existing transportation if space is available. Any student granted a waiver to continue at the school from out of zone may not provide "sibling preference" to other family members for the purposes of School Choice student assignment.
