Competitive Food Sales

The sale of all competitive food or beverages on school premises shall be prohibited except as provided herein. Competitive foods are those sold in competition with the National School Lunch Program and the National School Breakfast Program to students on school premises.

The sale of nutritional competitive foods or beverages shall be in accordance with the following guidelines:

- (1) Elementary Schools – Food or beverage items which make a nutritional contribution to the reimbursed meal may be sold at meal time with all proceeds going into the school Food Services account. Sale of competitive foods or beverages by other than Food Service is prohibited until after school hours.
- (2) Secondary Schools – If there is a Federal School Breakfast Program, the proceeds from all food and beverage items sold shall accrue to the Food Service account until after the close of the Breakfast Program. The proceeds from all food and beverage items sold during lunches until one (1) hour following the close of the last lunch period shall accrue to the school Food Service account. Water may be sold the entire day and the proceeds generated outside the cafeteria may accrue directly to the school.
