Renovations and Modifications to Facilities

School plants and facilities are intended primarily for educational purposes and for the benefit of students.

- (1) Requests by the building administrator for major landscaping and/or site work improvements shall have prior approval of the Director of Maintenance and Program Administrator for Safety, Security and Inspections.
- (2) Requests by the building administrator for additions, remodeling, renovation, air conditioning, or “change of use” to the interior or exterior of existing school buildings or school sites shall have prior approval of the Superintendent. Any such requested modification to school buildings or sites shall be in compliance with the Uniform Building Code for Public Educational Facilities Construction, Rule 6A-2, Florida Administrative Code.
- (3) Any work order affecting code requirements shall be reviewed and approved by the appropriately certified safety and building code plan reviewer; and inspected upon completion as required by law before placed in use. The final plan shall be shared with the appropriate fire district.
- (4) Each designated space within a District facility shall have appropriately labeled signage in compliance with the Florida Inventory of School Houses.
