Welcome

The meeting was called to order by Cindy McClung at 6:03 p.m.

All committee members introduced themselves to the group.

Cindy reminded committee members that the meetings are recorded, and the recording will be posted the day after the meeting on the CSI Board Advisory Committee website.

Parliamentary Procedures Training

Kathy Dupuy-Bruno, Esq., the District Board Attorney, reviewed the policies and procedures for the advisory committees.

The documents reviewed were provided to the Committee Members prior to the meeting, and are also available on the CSI Board Advisory Committee website.

Board Member Report

Ms. Gittens noted that the Strategic Plan touches all areas of the District, and that the work of this committee is charged with providing ideas, thoughts, and ways to make the district better through our Strategic Plan.

This is our second week of school, and there have a been a lot of wins and a lot of curves. Parents were given the opportunity to make any changes they wanted to make on their selection of how their student will participate in

school. There was some confusion between Lee Virtual and Lee Home Connect for parents, and there were quite a few things to work out with that situation and leveling off the numbers.

We are working through the COVID items. Children and staff are required to wear masks. If parents are concerned about how positive reports are being handled, there is a process in place for notifying all of the parents at that school.

The District website has a link available to provide details on positive COVID cases within the schools/district.

The Grab and Go program is still available, and open to students in Lee Virtual and Lee Home Connect. Ms. Gittens asked that committee members share this information with parents, and that details about dates and locations are on the District website.

The District YouTube channel provides a way to view Board meetings and is a great way to be kept up-to-date about the District and what is happening and being discussed.

Venue

Mr. Ryan made a motion that the committee meet in-person at the District office for the January 2021 meeting, and that the remainder of the meetings be held virtually via Zoom.

Ms. Defreitas seconded the motion.

The committee members unanimously approved the motion to meet via Zoom for the meetings during the 2020-2021 school year, with the exception of January 13, 2021, which will be an in-person meeting at the District office.

Mr. McLain made a motion to amend the venue motion to include attending the meeting via Zoom is an acceptable form of attendance for the January 2021 meeting.

Mr. Baucom seconded the motion.

The committee members unanimously approved the amended motion that Zoom will be an acceptable form of attendance for the January 2021 meeting.

Priorities

Cindy provided an overview of the District Strategic Plan, including updates on some areas that have evolved due to the COVID situation.

Ms. Gittens discussed items in the list of initiatives that cover all parts of the plan, and are very timely during the unusual times we are in, including increasing focus on meeting the needs of the whole students, expanding key technological innovations, and deployment of systemic processes.

Dr. Stork noted that reviewing specific pieces of each area would help the committee to be more granular on these larger topics.

Mr. Ryan noted that providing a common form of communication to all interested parties is important.

Cindy suggested sending out a survey regarding the topics discussed at the meeting tonight, and committee members will then rank the topics, and Cindy will use that data to schedule presentations by key stakeholders in each area.


