

Changes in 2023 - 2024

- Create 3 new printed books (vs. 6 books) with the combined elementary and secondary codes
- Create a landing page for full content in place of ADA PDFs (which allows the user to access in multiple languages)
- Level 1-5 are now aligned with state coding
- Inclusion of QR Codes
- Removal of information that was not directly related to the code
- Threat towards a teacher moved to a level 2 offense

Projected Need for 2024 - 2025

- 6 Books Total
 - 3 Print (English, Spanish, Creole for Primary/Secondary)
 - 3 Electronic ADA (English, Spanish, Creole for Primary/Secondary)
- Process
 - Create and review draft (redline version) using community, student, and school staff feedback
 - Translations in Spanish and Creole for paper copies
 - Add new photos
 - Work through edits with the School Board
- Finalize document and translate to Spanish and Creole (paper copies)



Current Suggestions for 2024-2025 Code

- Update off-campus felony verbiage to align with law enforcement
- Consider moving Grand Theft and Hazing to Level 2
- Define personal electronics to include smartwatches
- Ensure discipline process clarifies parent and guardian involvement
- Ensure language for searches is aligned with state statute
- Include misuse of AI (under cheating)
- Increase consistency of discipline processes among schools
- Review horseplay vs. physical attack

Student Open Enrollment

- Student Open Enrollment (24-25 School Year) starts at 8 a.m. on January 26 and ends at 4 p.m. on February 29
- Parents of current students without a Focus Parent Portal account must create one.
- Middle School Arts Program Application Period ends Jan. 26, 4pm.
 - Middle school parents can get form from the middle school they are applying for. More information available on school website.
- Lottery Results will be available in the Focus Parent Portal **April 5**, 2024. School of enrollments will be emailed to parent and added to the Focus Parent Portal.



Middle School Continuation

- > The Middle School Continuation form is in the Focus Parent Portal.
- If you select to keep your current school, you **do not** complete a School Choice Application.
- > If you select to stay in your new zone, you **do** need to complete the School Choice Application.
- Students assigned to a K-8 school out of their Proximity Zone will not be provided transportation by the District.
- ➤ If you need a school within your Proximity Zone, you *must* submit a School Choice Application.
- Rising 5th graders with siblings in a Middle school will be placed in the same school.
- Note: If the student is in zone, attends a K-8 school or in an ESE self-contained program a message in red will appear and you do not need to take action.


