STAR scores are reported as Percentile Ranks (PR). The Percentile Rank compares your child's scores with that of other students in the same grade across the United States. A Percentile Rank of 55, for example, indicates that this student has scored better than 55% of the students in his/her grade level.

i-Ready scores are reported as Scale Scores (SS). i-Ready's diagnostic assessment provides a **scaled score** (ranges from 0 to 800) that can be tracked and compared across grade levels. i-Ready tests are administered three times per school year (Fall, Winter, Spring). They are designed to be a measure of growth over time. We would expect to see student's scores moving toward mid and late in the Winter and Spring.

Explanation of i-Ready Test Placement Levels (categories):

Below: the student is placing one, or more, grade levels below

Early: the student is At Grade Level for the Fall Diagnostic Test (Baseline)

Mid: the student is At Grade Level for the Winter Diagnostic Test (Quarter 2)

Late: the student is At Grade Level for the Spring Diagnostic Test (Quarter 3)

Above: the student is placing above level
