HOW TO APPLY FOR DAR SCHOLARSHIPS

The Estero Island Chapter NSDAR is searching for students who excel in academics, leadership, community service and extra-curricular activities to apply for national and state scholarships.

NSDAR: The National Society Daughters of the American Revolution awards multiple scholarships to students showing dedication to the pursuit of degrees in diverse disciplines including history, law, nursing, and education. Scholarship information, application and financial need forms can be found at www.dar.org/national-society/scholarships. Students should pay close attention to the requirements for each scholarship. Photos will result in disqualification and should NOT be included.

All transcripts, letters of recommendation and other required documents must be submitted together in a single email to the national vice chair of the specific scholarship postmarked no later than February 10, 2019.

Chapter sponsorship signatures are not required for NSDAR applications.

FSSAR: Florida State Society Daughters of the American Revolution has scholarships open to any student who is a high school senior (2019 or earlier graduate). Any FSSDAR scholarship winners with applications sponsored by EIDAR will not only get the state \$500 but a matching \$500 from our chapter making a total award of \$1000. Applicants must attend an accredited college/university either in Florida or out of state and be sponsored by a local DAR chapter. More than one student from each high school may apply. Any DAR member can access the checklist, application and financial need forms through the member state website which is password protected. Students should contact us regarding the correct forms to use. All completed documents for FSSDAR Scholarships must be received by the EIDAR Scholarship Chair by March 15, 2019.
