Curriculum Advisory Committee (CUAC) shall consist of fifteen members. The Board will appoint fifteen members to the Curriculum Advisory Committee, three selected by each School Board Member. Each Board Member will make reasonable efforts to ensure that at least one of his/her appointees resides in that Member's residence area and at least one is a minority. Every effort shall be made to ensure that a balance of parents, community members, and persons who have substantial knowledge and experience in learning theory, curriculum design, standards-based instruction, or instructional technology represented on the committee. The Superintendent shall assign no more than three appropriate District staff as liaisons. The Superintendent may also appoint additional members to this committee to ensure that the interests of exceptional students are represented. The purpose of the curriculum committee shall be to provide input, advice, and support to curriculum content, materials and assessment instruments and to the school improvement process. The committee will also provide input, advice, and support to District-wide technology issues and promote the integration of technology into the home and school learning environments.
