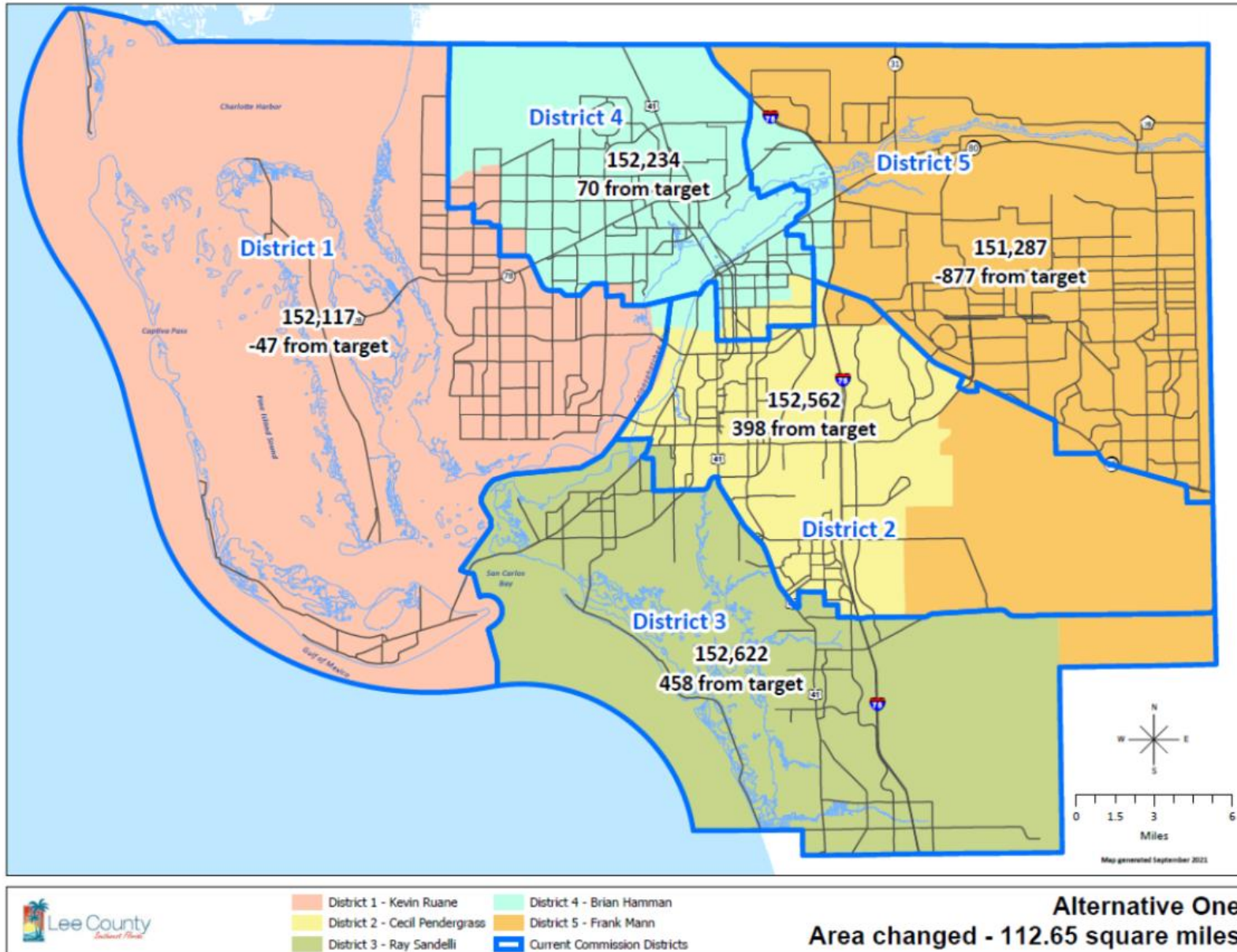

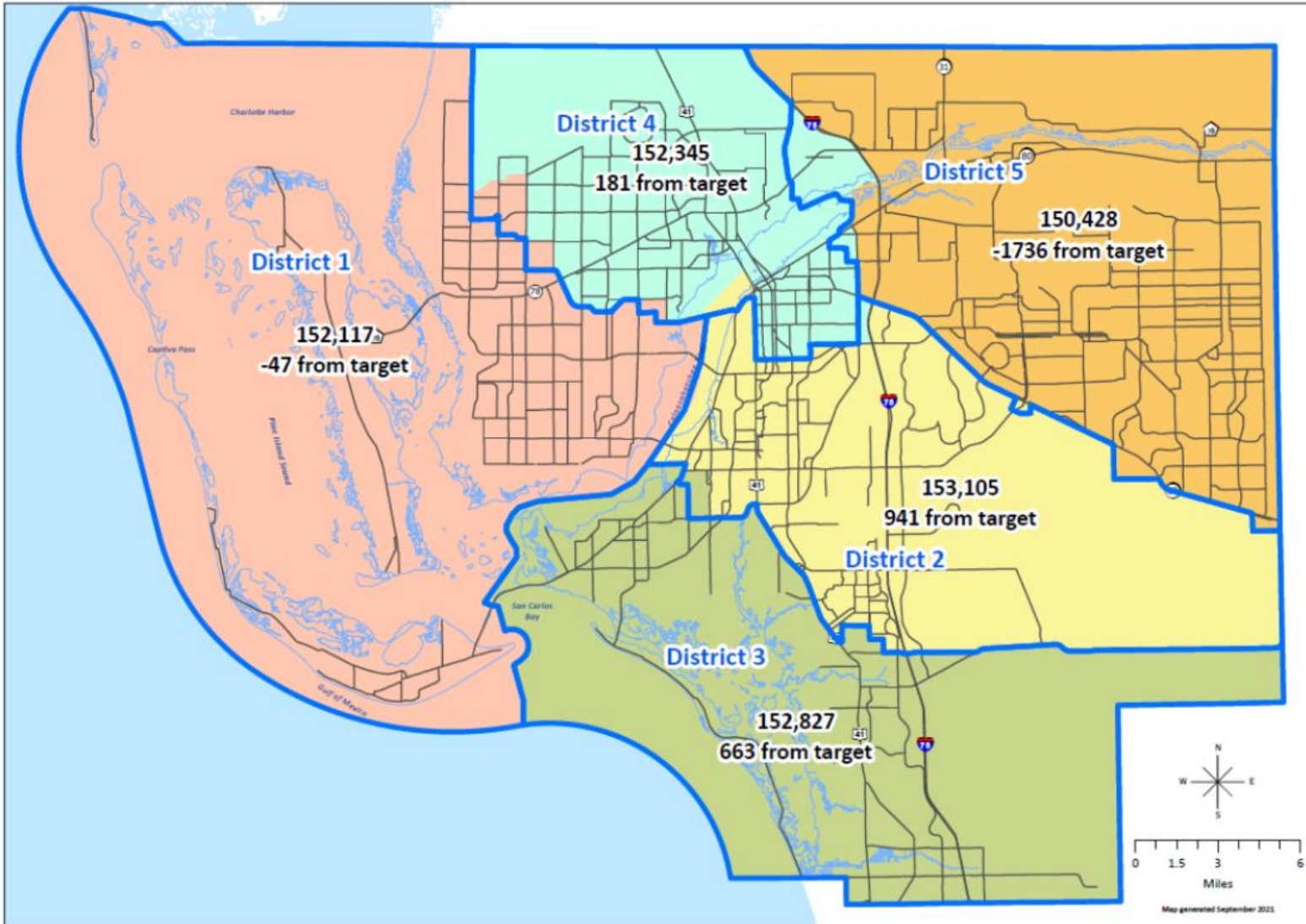
Strengths	Challenges

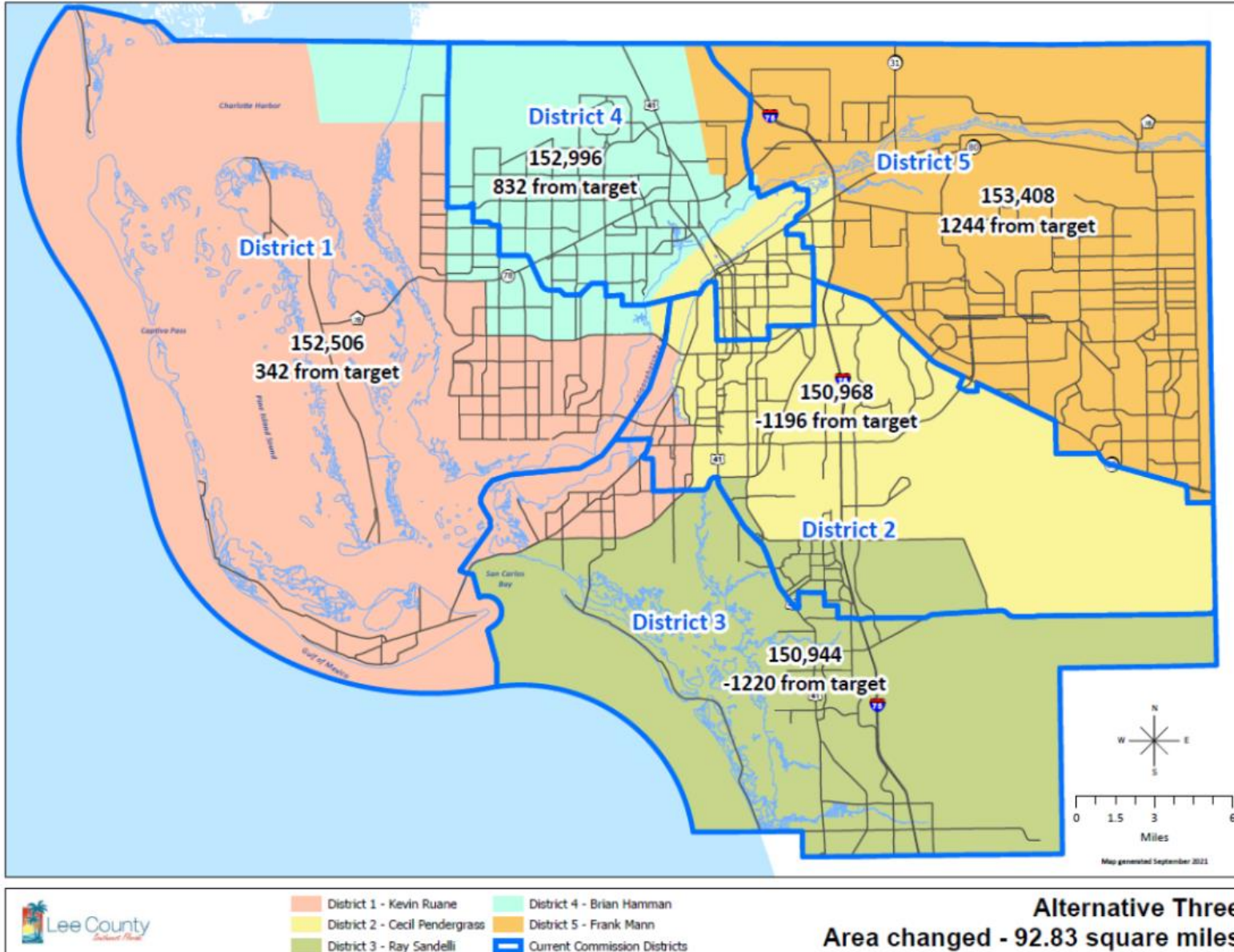

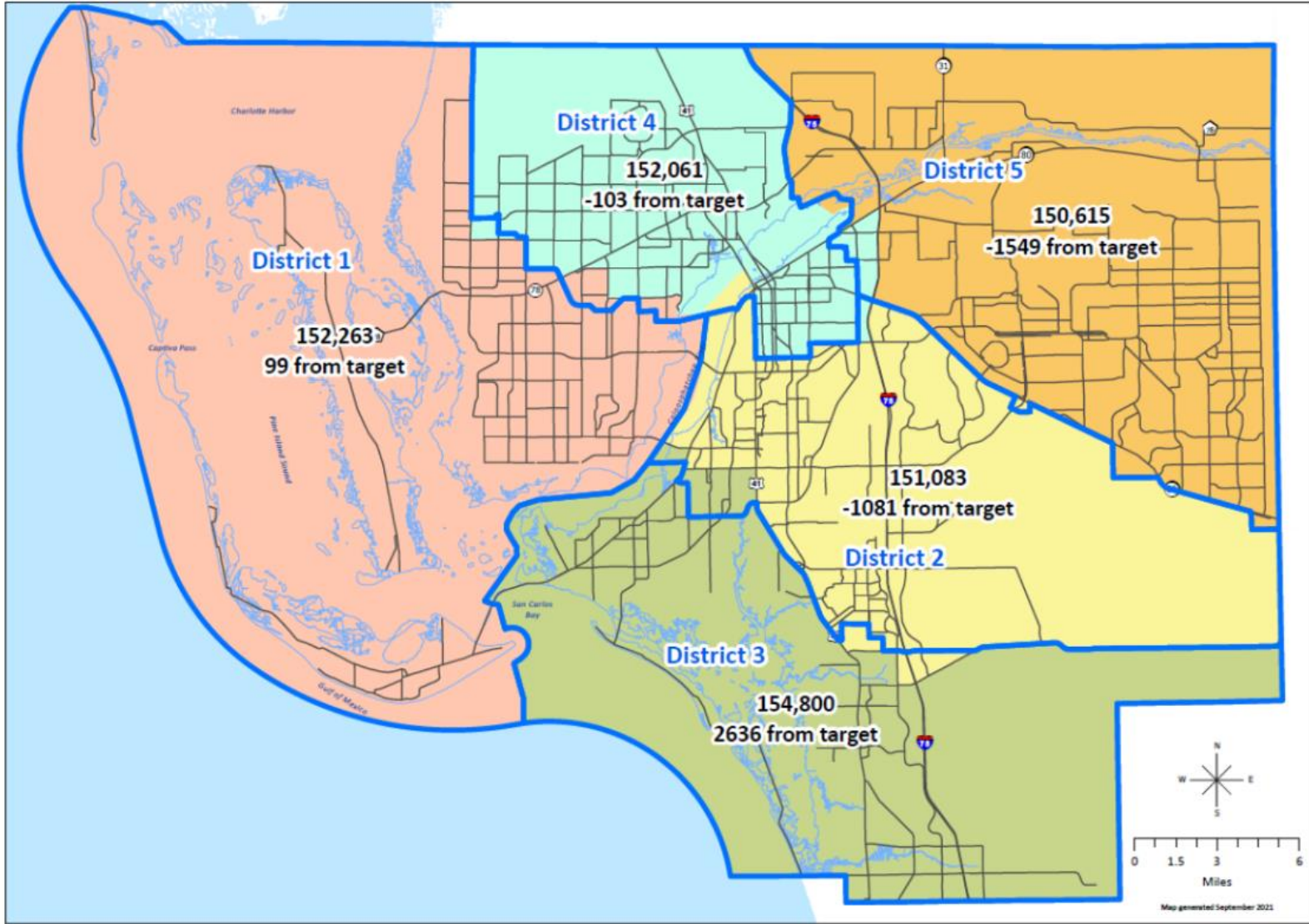

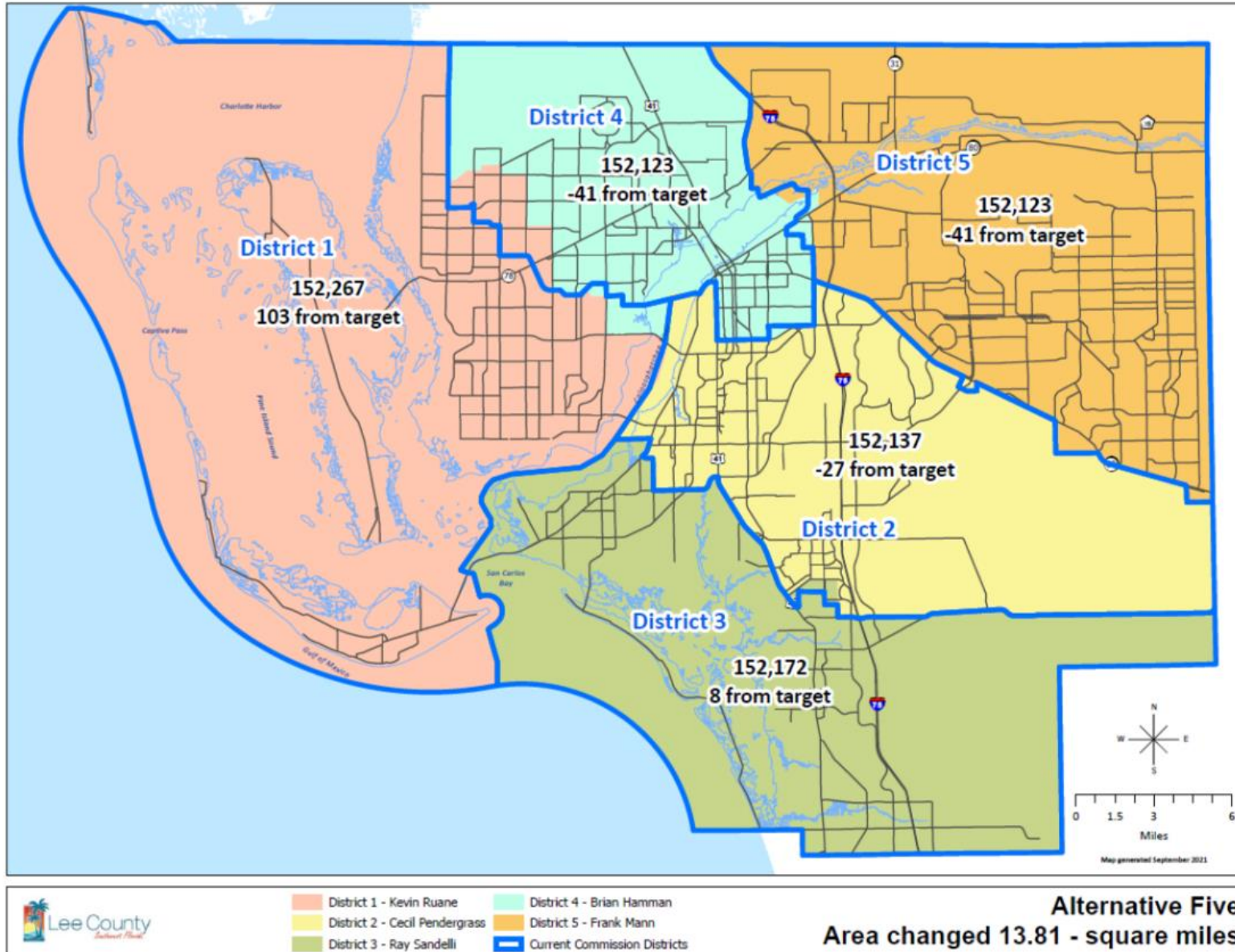

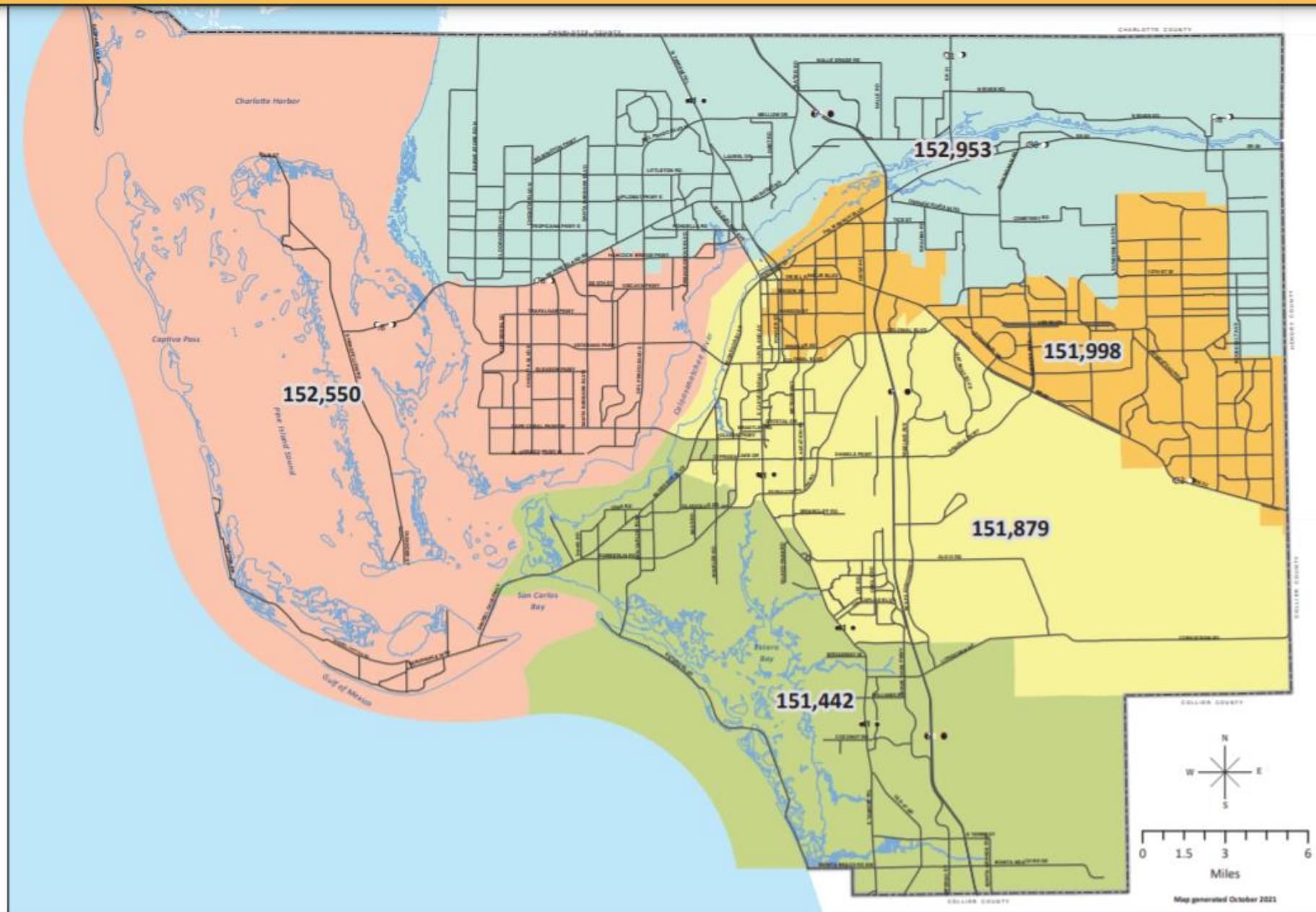

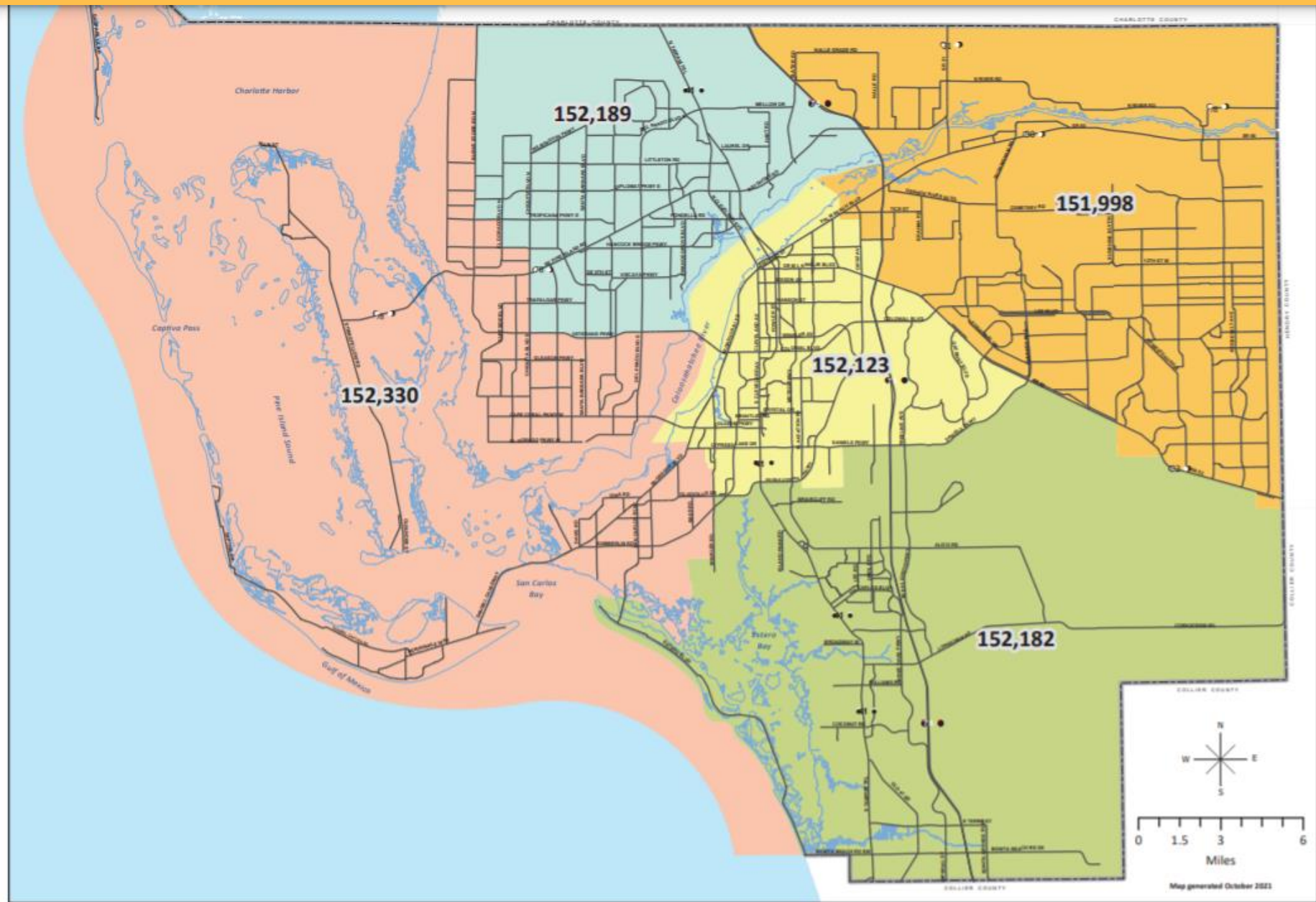
