## Background Information:

ITN No. N177302DG is an annual ITN for electrical maintenance and repairs throughout the District. Services include electrical work performed by a licensed electrical contractor for all District sites, as directed by the Maintenance Services Department on an as needed basis. It is recommended that the award be made to Southwest Florida Electric, Inc. and All Phase Electric Service of Florida, Inc. It is recommended that the contract be effective for three years beginning December 29, 2017 through December 28, 2020, with renewal options for three additional one year periods, upon the written agreement of the vendors and the District, at the estimated expenditure of \$400,000.00 for the first year. Twentyfive vendors were notified of the bid; two vendors submitted a response; one vendor submitted a no bid; and 22 vendors did not respond.

#### Fiscal Impact:

The estimated expenditure for the first year of \$400,000.00 will be funded from Maintenance Services Department budgeted funds. This agenda item is specifically for the approval of the ITN. Funds will only be expended within the existing resources of the applicable location(s).
