Background Information:

Bid No. B177304LN is for Specialty Diet Foods for all District schools, and includes a variety of diet foods that are low carb, gluten free and contain vitamins and supplements. The products are required so the District may serve students who have food allergies. On June 27, 2017, this bid was awarded to Ada's Natural Market, Perdue Foods, LLC, and The Skinny Pantry, LLC, for three years beginning June 27, 2017 through June 26, 2020, with renewal options for three additional one year periods, upon the written agreement of the vendors and the District. It is recommended that the Board approve the estimated expenditure of \$100,000.00 for the second year period of the base contract, June 27, 2018 through June 26, 2019, pursuant to the same terms and conditions previously approved by the Board.

Fiscal Impact:

The estimated expenditure of \$100,000.00 will be funded from budgeted Food and Nutrition Services Department funds. This agenda item is specifically for the approval of the expenditure. Funds will only be expended within the existing resources of the applicable location(s).
