### Background Information:

Contract No. C177288LN is for aluminum walkway covers and entry canopies, and canvas walkway covers and entry canopies. The contract was awarded to Architectural Metals of SW Florida, Inc., Coastal Contracting of Florida, LLC, and Marco Canvas & Upholstery, LLC, and is effective for three years beginning May 2, 2017 through May 1, 2020, with renewal options for three additional one year periods, upon the written agreement of the vendors and the District. It is recommended that the Board approve the estimated expenditure of \$1,800,000.00 for the second year of the base contract, for the period of May 2, 2018 through May 1, 2019.
