- We need to continue to look into what is the best way to share information with families
- Discussion about the sub-committee Families helping families will assist
- Recommend having a one-page information on specific disabilities like dyslexia, etc.

Board Presentation – Theresa Bowen shared the 3-year comparison of students with disabilities taken from the October FTE period.

- American Rescue Plan IDEA update
 - Will be targeting the social emotional piece to assist with behavior. Social opportunities (CBI Community based instruction)
 - o Increase behavior analyst
 - o Pre-k assessment team they have a complete backlog also pandemic related
 - o Purchase materials for teachers

Brief discussion regarding supported employment opportunities. Barb Williams is amazing. Some local Publix will welcome our students; however, the corporate office has said no. WAWA no longer wants to work together with our unpaid supported employment. Many of our schools have done a good job creating employment opportunities on campus. Utilizing smaller businesses becomes a staffing issue, however, they have been very welcoming. Busing is also a challenge this year.
