

## TALC CONTRACT NEGOTIATIONS FY22 (2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR) JOINT COMMUNICATION

## **April 11, 2022**

The TALC and District bargaining teams reached a Tentative Agreement on March 31, 2022 for a successor agreement to the FY21 TALC Collective Bargaining Agreement. The Tentative Agreement includes a plan regarding the distribution of the Teacher Salary Increase Allocation (TSIA) funding from the State and increases compensation using bargaining authority funding provided by the School Board.

The TALC Labor/Management Committee established tentative dates for TALC ratification, Board approval, and implementation of updates to the TALC Contract resulting from FY22 (2021-2022 school year) collective bargaining sessions.

The dates below were agreed upon by the TALC Labor/Management Committee with dates related to ratification contigent upon approval of a petition for authority from the Florida Public Employee Relations Commission (PERC) to conduct an electronic ratification:

August 30, 2021: TALC Bargaining began

March 31, 2022: Tentative Agreement reached

**April 13, 2022:** Tentative Agreement sent to TALC for review

**April 19, 2022:** Tentative Agreement sent to Instructional Staff

**April 22, 2022:** Information Session video to be sent out electronically and

posted on the District website

**April 29, 2022:** ESSER Retention Bonus #1 to be paid to Instructional Staff

May 4, 2022: TALC E-Ratification Vote

May/June 2022: Memorandum of Understanding to go to Board for

approval and implementation to occur
