Recommended Action	Approval to piggyback The School Board of Volusia County ITB No. TR-21-004MB, for Recapped & New Tires and Related Tire Services, awarded to Earl W. Colvard, Inc. d/b/a Boulevard Tire Center of Fort Myers, FL, for the period of October 20, 2023, through October 13, 2024, for up to \$400,000.00, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District. This contract supports the purchase of recapped tires for the District's Bus Fleet and White Fleet Vehicles. The vendor will pick up used tires to be processed and then deliver the processed recapped tires to the Transportation Services bus depots to be mounted on District buses. Approval authorizes the Superintendent to execute all related documents.

The School Board of Volusia County ITB No. TR-21-004MB, for Recapped & New Tires and Related Tire Services, was awarded to Earl W. Colvard, Inc. d/b/a Boulevard Tire Center of Fort Myers, FL, for the period of October 14, 2020, through October 13, 2023, and renewed through October 13, 2024. This contract supports the purchase of recapped tires for the District's Bus Fleet and White Fleet Vehicles. The vendor will pick up used tires to be processed and then deliver the processed recapped tires to the Transportation Services bus depots to be mounted on District buses. It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$400,000.00, for the period of October 20, 2023, through October 13, 2024, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
