Invitation to Negotiate No. N207376RC is for Irrigation Repair & Replacement. Services include maintenance and repairs related to underground water lines, electrical line repairs and/or well pump replacements on an as needed basis. On July 28, 2020, this ITN was awarded to P&T Lawn and Tractor Service, Inc. located in Alva, FL and Shaw Irrigation, LLC located in Fort Myers, FL, for a three-year period, beginning July 28, 2020 through July 27, 2023, and renewed through July 27, 2024 with two more renewal options available. It is recommended the Board approve the renewal with P&T Lawn and Tractor Service, Inc. located in Alva, FL and Shaw Irrigation, LLC located in Fort Myers, FL for the second renewal period of July 28, 2024 through July 27, 2025, for up to \$325,000.00, pursuant to the same terms and conditions as previously approved by the Board.
