Budget Source	Up to \$600,000.00 will be funded from budgeted School/Department funds. This agenda item is specifically for the approval of the piggyback. Funds will only be expended within the existing resources of the applicable locations.
Recommended Action	Approval to piggyback Pinellas County Public Schools Bid No. 20-480-077, for Digital Catalog Discounts, awarded to multiple vendors with locations in Lee County, for the period of January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, for up to \$600,000.00, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District. This contract supports items purchased at discount prices to include: art supplies and equipment; educational products, services and technology; math, language arts, science and social studies supplies and equipment; technical college classroom supplies and equipment; musical instruments and supplies; and general classroom supplies. Approval authorizes the Superintendent to execute all related documents.

Pinellas County Public Schools Bid No. 20-480-077, for Digital Catalog Discounts, was awarded to multiple vendors with locations in Lee County, for the period of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2024. This contract supports items purchased at discount prices to include: art supplies and equipment; educational products, services and technology; math, language arts, science and social studies supplies and equipment; technical college classroom supplies and equipment; musical instruments and supplies; and general classroom supplies. It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$600,000.00, for the period of January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
