Sourcewell RFP No. 041123, for Sports Lighting Solutions with Related Technology, Equipment, and Services, was awarded to multiple vendors including but not limited to, Musco Sports Lighting, LLC in Oskaloosa, Iowa, for the period of June 23, 2023 through June 16, 2027. This contract will allow the Maintenance Services Department to purchase both products and services for field and parking lot lighting. The anticipated projects include, but are not limited to:

- \$540,000.00 – Mariner High School: Softball field, baseball field, and tennis court Lights (Capital Project Fund)
- \$500,000.00 - Lehigh Senior High School: Softball and baseball field lights (Capital Project Fund)
- \$500,000.00 – Ida S. Baker High School: Softball and baseball field lights (Capital Project Fund)

It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$1,540,000.00, for the period of June 17, 2024 through June 16, 2025, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
