GSA Advantage GS-03F-113DA, for Multi Award Schedule, was awarded to multiple vendors including Landoll Company, LLC, in Marysville, KS, (Briggs Equipment of Lehigh Acres, FL is the local authorized dealer) and Nilfisk, Inc., in Brooklyn Park, MN, (Grainger Industrial Supply a Division of W.W. Grainger of Fort Myers, FL is the local authorized dealer) for the period of June 10, 2016, through June 12, 2026. This contract piggyback includes commercial goods and services organized by 12 large categories and multiple subcategories, including but not limited to: floor care equipment, utility trucks, tractors and forklifts. It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$400,000.00, for the period of April 23, 2024, through April 22, 2025, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
