Collier County BOCC RFP 23-8177, for Gas and Diesel Fuel, was awarded to Palmdale Oil Company, Inc., in Fort Myers, FL, for the period of April 6, 2024 through April 5, 2027. This contract supports furnishing and delivering unleaded gasoline and diesel fuel for buses and fleet vehicles. This is a collaborative, multi-agency solicitation. The District's Procurement Services Department and Transportation Services Department collaborated with other agencies to define specifications, evaluate responses and recommend a vendor. Purchase prices are based on daily published rates for fuel. It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$6,500,000.00, for the period of April 9, 2024, through April 5, 2025, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
