Recommended Action	Approval to piggyback Lee County Board of County Commissioners ITB No. B220607KLB, for Rental and Servicing of Portable Toilets, awarded to Toilets to Go, LLC (Formerly John to Go FL, LLC), in Ringwood, NJ; with a local office in North Fort Myers, FL (Primary) and United Site Services of Florida, LLC, in Westborough, MA; with a local office in Fort Myers, FL (Secondary), for the period of February 21, 2025 through February 20, 2026, for up to \$125,000.00, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District. Approval authorizes the Superintendent to execute all related documents.

Lee County Board of County Commissioners ITB No. B220607KLB, for Rental and Servicing of Portable Toilets, was awarded to Toilets to Go, LLC (Formerly John to Go FL, LLC), in Ringwood, NJ; with a local office in North Fort Myers, FL (Primary) and United Site Services of Florida, LLC, in Westborough, MA; with a local office in Fort Myers, FL (Secondary), for the period of February 21, 2023 through February 20, 2026. This piggyback will support the rental and servicing of portable wash stations and toilets on an as-needed basis.

It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$125,000.00, for the period of February 21, 2025 through February 20, 2026, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
