Budget Source	The increase of up to \$140,000.00 will be funded from budgeted School/Department funds. This agenda item is specifically for a one-time approval to increase the previously Board approved amount of \$85,000.00 by \$140,000.00, for up to \$225,000.00. Funds will only be expended within the existing resources of the applicable locations.
Recommended Action	Approval to increase the previously Board approved amount of \$85,000.00 by \$140,000.00, for up to \$225,000.00, with BlueTriton Brands, Inc., in Fort Myers, FL, for the period of January 13, 2026 through July 28, 2026, pursuant to the same terms and conditions as previously approved by the Board. The \$140,000.00 increase is requested due to water being added as a component to school lunches and to cover any unforeseen usage and/or emergencies. Approval authorizes the Superintendent to execute all related documents.

Contract No. C257490JA is for Bottled Water. Services and products include the purchase and delivery of bottled water to school cafeterias and the Southwest Florida Public Service Academy as well as for emergency water main breaks and shelter schools as needed. On July 29, 2025 the School Board of Lee County approved this SDLC Contract, awarded to BlueTriton Brands, Inc., in Fort Myers, FL, beginning July 29, 2025 through July 28, 2028. The \$140,000.00 increase is requested due to bottled water being added as a component to school snack menus and to cover any unforeseen usage and/or emergencies. It is recommended the Board approve the increase to the previously Board approved expenditure amount of \$85,000.00, by \$140,000.00, for up to \$225,000.00, with BlueTriton Brands, Inc., in Fort Myers, FL, for the period of January 13, 2026 through July 28, 2026, pursuant to the same terms and conditions as previously approved by the Board.
