Duval County Public Schools ITB No. ITB-011-23/JR, for Finger Printing Services, was awarded to Fieldprint, Inc., in Mount Laurel, NJ, for the period of September 15, 2022 through September 30 2023 renewed through September 30, 2024 with an anticipated renewal through September 30, 2025. This contract supports the District schools' requirement to have medical students and before/after school program employees fingerprinted through a clearinghouse. It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$65,000.00, for the period of October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
