Invitation to Negotiate No. N217406DG is for Fire Extinguishers and Hood Suppression Systems - Inspect, Maintain, Repair and Replace. Services include maintenance, inspection, replacement and repair of District fire extinguishers of various types, including cafeteria hood suppression systems, and ensures the District is compliant with the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) standards. On November 16, 2021, this ITN was awarded to Fyr-Fyter, Inc., in Fort Myers, FL and Iowa Fire Equipment Company, in Fort Myers, FL, for a three-year period, beginning November 16, 2021 through November 15, 2024, with renewal options for three additional one-year periods, upon the written agreement of the vendors and the District. It is recommended the Board approve the renewal with Fyr-Fyter, Inc., in Fort Myers, FL for the first renewal period of November 16, 2024 through November 15, 2025, for up to \$275,000.00, pursuant to the same terms and conditions as previously approved by the Board. Iowa Fire Equipment Company did not respond to the renewal request.
