Lee County Board of County Commissioners ITB No. B210268LLP, for Lubricant Products - Countywide, was awarded to Palmdale Oil Company, LLC, with locations in Fort Myers, FL, and Horseless Carriage Aficionado, LLC d/b/a Mighty Auto Parts of SWFL, in Cape Coral, FL, for the period of October 19, 2021, through October 18, 2024, and renewed through October 18, 2025. This contract supports the purchase of products, such as motor oil, gear lube, Diesel Exhaust Fluid (DEF), chassis lube, transmission fluid, power steering fluid, wheel bearing grease and antifreeze. It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$247,500.00, for the period of October 19, 2024, through October 18, 2025, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
