- SCOPE:** The purpose and intent of this request for quote is to secure firm prices for Stage Rigging Inspections.
- CONTRACT TERM:** The District anticipates awarding a contract for three (3) years. The contract (or any portion thereof) has the option of being renewed for three (3) additional one (1) year periods, for a total duration not to exceed six (6) years, upon mutual agreement of both parties, under the same terms and conditions. The District, through its Department of Procurement Services, will, if considering renewal, request a letter of intent to renew from each awardee, prior to the end of the current contract period. The awardee will be notified when the recommendation has been acted upon by the District. The vendor agrees to this condition by signing its quote. An alternate award strategy may be implemented at the sole discretion of the District. Post award project work will be distributed at the discretion of the District.
- ADDITION OR DELETION OF SITES:** Sites to be serviced are listed in Exhibit 1, School District of Lee County Locations. The District reserves the right to add or delete locations at its discretion at any time throughout the term of this quote. Any additional equipment/facility added during the term of this agreement will be handled in accordance with the conditions and prices of this agreement.

4. **NEW SERVICES:** New products may be added during the term of the contract, upon completion of successful price negotiations between the District and the awarded Contractor:
5. **LICENSES:** Contractor must possess a Lee County local business tax receipt (formerly known as Lee County Occupational License) or license from another county in the State of Florida prior to the proposal opening date. A copy shall be included with the proposal.
6. **TECHNICIANS:** All services under this RFQ shall be performed by technicians employed by the Contractor whom have been employed in the industry for a minimum of three (3) years. Contractor shall submit a list of all current employees that may perform services under this RFQ on any District site. List shall include employee name, number of years employed by Contractor and number of years in the stage rigging industry. Failure to submit list may be cause for rejection of bid. Contractor shall submit with the bid, a letter stating that all technicians it employs have been properly trained and certified if necessary to perform the required services under this RFQ.
7. **SUBCONTRACTORS:** Contractor shall at no time during the contract, subcontract the work to be performed under this RFQ. The actual stage rigging inspections and any stage rigging repair services under this RFQ shall be performed by the awarded contractor and its own employees. Failure to comply shall be grounds for immediate termination of contract.
8. **DAY LABORERS:** Contractor shall at no time during the contract use day laborers to perform any work under this RFQ. Any personnel of the Contractor performing work at any District site shall be documented per this RFQ. Failure to comply shall be grounds for immediate termination of contract.
9. **SCHEDULING:** Contractor shall contact each school to set up a schedule with the school administrators. A copy of the master schedule shall be sent to the Safety and Security Department.
10. **SAFETY DATA SHEETS:** Supplies requested which are listed on the Florida Substance List (substances covered under Chapter 442, Florida Statutes) are required to have published Safety Data Sheets. Contractor(s) will be required to submit a copy of the SDS for any and all such substances to the Supervisor of the Safety and Security Department, prior to the start of contract. Failure to provide SDS may be cause for termination of contract.

A copy of your current insurance certificate is required immediately upon notification of award.

All Contractors on District property shall be properly badged through the fingerprint and background screening process described below. An existing universal Florida School District badge is acceptable.

Contractor Process for Fingerprinting: Upon award, Contractor is required to comply with the requirements of Florida Statutes, Section 1012.32, 1012.465, 1012.467 and 1012.468 and the School District of Lee County Board Policy 5.04, Fingerprinting and Background screening, sections

4 and 5. Among other compliance items included in this policy, section 5 (a) and (b) state: (a) Prior to the start of work on any District site, all construction contractors and other Contractors including but not limited to construction manager, company owners, architects, engineers, specialty contractors, subcontractors and personnel for the same shall be subject to a criminal background check to determine eligibility to perform work on a District site, unless the individual meets an exception as defined in §1012.468, Florida Statutes. Individuals subject to a criminal background screening under this section shall pay the processing and maintenance fee required for all appropriate background checks.

In the event a contract results in the deployment of personnel, whether they are a direct employee of the contractor or a subcontractor, to a District construction site or any District property it is the responsibility of the contractor to follow the requirements of this policy.

Contractor Fingerprinting - Frequently Asked Questions and Cost: The cost for fingerprinting, and answers to frequently asked questions (FAQs) related to the fingerprinting process, are located on the School District's website: <http://www.leeschools.net/vendor-fingerprinting-faq>.

Contractor shall strictly limit its operations to the designated work areas and shall not permit any employees to enter any other portions of District property without District's expressed prior written consent. All Contractors are prohibited from distributing any papers or other materials upon District property and are strictly prohibited from using any District telephones or other office equipment. All Contractors shall enter and leave District facilities only through the ingress and egress points designated, from time to time, by The District. The Contractor shall be responsible for the removal of all trash and debris occasioned by this contract. Failure to adhere to this requirement will result in the costs of the performance of this work by others being charged to the Contractor.

### **CONTRACTOR PERFORMANCE AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Contractor shall provide competent, suitable, qualified personnel to perform any project required by the Request for Quote. The Contractor shall at all times maintain good discipline and order while on District property. The Contractor shall furnish all equipment, labor, transportation, construction equipment and machinery, tools, and appliances necessary for the initial operation and completion of any project unless otherwise specified. The Contractor shall be responsible for the appearance and demeanor of all personnel assigned to the project and shall require that all employees wear shirts with visible company logo and personal identification of the individual employee. Uniforms and/or dress code shall be inclusive of, but not limited to, neat and clean company uniforms or attire that are appropriate and easily identifiable.

The Contractor's personnel shall have no contact with students or school staff, other than administrative staff or designated representatives, with the exception of emergency situations. The Contractor's employees shall refrain from using foul, abusive, or profane language on District property. The Contractor's personnel shall be aware that all District sites are smoke free areas. The use of tobacco products is prohibited on any property owned by The District. Contractor's personnel shall be aware that it is illegal to have in one's possession any firearm, illegal drug or alcoholic beverage while on District property.

**The Contractor shall be responsible for all damages caused by the Contractor and shall be held responsible for replacing or repairing any damage due to negligence on their part to any person(s) and/or property.** The District may withhold payment or make such deductions as deemed necessary to insure reimbursement or replacement for loss or damage to property. Any existing surface or subsurface improvements, including, but not limited to, pavements, curbs, sidewalks, pipes, utilities, footings, structures, trees and shrubbery, not indicated in the contract documents to be removed or altered, shall be protected by Contractor from damage during the prosecution of any project. Any such improvements so damaged shall be restored by Contractor to condition at least equal to that existing at the time of Contractor's commencement of any project.

### **FEDERAL GRANTS TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

For any solicitation that involves, receives or utilizes Federal Grants funding, the following terms and conditions shall be considered a part of the solicitation and resulting award and the Contractor accepts and acknowledges that it is and will continue to comply with said terms and conditions for the term of the award:

1. **Illegal Alien Labor:** Contractor shall comply with all federal and state laws prohibiting the hiring and continued employment of aliens not authorized to work in the United States. Contractor must not knowingly employ unauthorized aliens and should such violation occur shall be cause for cancellation of the contract. The Contractor and its Subcontractors will utilize the E-verify system established by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security to verify the employment eligibility of its employees.
2. **Recovered Material (2 CFR §200.322):** **applies to all contracts greater than \$10,000.00.** Contractor must comply with Section 6002 of the Solid Waste Disposal Act, as amended by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act. The requirements of Section 6002 include procuring only items designated in guidelines of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) at 40 CFR part 247 that contain the highest percentage of recovered materials practicable, consistent with maintaining a satisfactory level of competition, where the purchase price of the item exceeds \$10,000.00 or the value of the quantity acquired during the District's preceding fiscal year exceeded \$10,000.00; procuring solid waste management services in a manner that maximizes energy and resource recovery; and establishing an affirmative procurement program for procurement of recovered materials identified in the EPA guidelines.
3. **Federal Drug-Free Workplace:** Contractor agrees to comply with the drug-free workplace requirements for federal contracts pursuant to 41 U.S.C.A. § 8102.
4. **Byrd Anti-Lobbying Amendment (31 U.S.C. 1352):** **applies if contract is greater than or equal to \$100,000.00.** Contractor certifies that it has filed the required certification and that it will not and has not used Federal appropriated funds to pay any person or organization for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of an agency, a member of Congress, officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a member of Congress in connection with obtaining any Federal contract, grant or any other award covered by 31 U.S.C. 1352. Contractor must disclose any lobbying with non-Federal funds that takes place in connection with obtaining any Federal award.
5. **Energy Efficiency / Conservation (42 U.S.C. 6201):** Contractor agrees to comply with the mandatory standards and policies relating to energy efficiency contained in the state energy

conservation plan issued in compliance with the Energy Policy and Conservation Act (42 U.S.C. 6201).

6. **Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7401 Et Seq.) and the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq.), as amended applies to contracts and subgrants in excess of \$150,000:** Contractor agrees to comply with all applicable standards, orders or regulations issued pursuant to the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7401-7671q) and the Federal Water Pollution Control Act as amended (33 U.S.C. 1251-1387). Contractor shall report any and all violations to the Federal awarding agency and the Regional Office of the EPA and notify the District concurrently within 30 days of notice of the violation.
7. **Debarment and Suspension:** Contractor certifies that it complies fully with the Federal Debarment Certification regarding debarment suspension, ineligibility and voluntary exclusion. In accordance with 2 CFR part 180 that implement Executive Orders 12549 and 12689. Furthermore, Contractor certifies that neither it nor its principals is presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from participation in this transaction by any federal department or agency.
8. **Equal Employment Opportunity:** During the performance of this contract, the Contractor agrees as follows:
  - a) The Contractor will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, or national origin. The Contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, or national origin. Such action shall include, but not be limited to the following: employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The Contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the contracting officer setting forth the provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.
  - b) The Contractor will, in all solicitations or advancements for employees placed by or on behalf of the Contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, or national origin.
  - c) The Contractor will not discharge or in any other manner discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because such employee or applicant has inquired about, discussed, or disclosed the compensation of the employee or applicant or another employee or applicant. This provision shall not apply to instances in which an employee who has access to the compensation information of other employees or applicants as a part of such employee's essential job functions discloses the compensation of such other employees or applicants to individuals who do not otherwise have access to such information, unless such disclosure is in response to a formal complaint or charge, in furtherance of an investigation, proceeding, hearing, or action, including an investigation conducted by the employer, or is consistent with the Contractor's legal duty to furnish information.
  - d) The Contractor will send to each labor union or representative of workers with which he has a collective bargaining agreement or other contract or understanding, a Record Retention and access requirements to all records. The Contractor will send to each labor

union or representative of workers with which he has a collective bargaining agreement or other contract or understanding, a notice, to be provided by the agency contracting officer, advising the labor union or workers' representative of the Contractor's commitments under Section 202 of Executive Order No. 11246 of September 24, 1965, and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.

- e) The Contractor will comply with all provisions of Executive Order No. 11246 of Sept. 24, 1965, and of the rules, regulations, and relevant orders of the Secretary of Labor.
  - f) The Contractor will furnish all information and reports required by Executive Order No. 11246 of September 24, 1965, and by the rules, regulations, and orders of the Secretary of Labor, or pursuant thereto, and will permit access to his books, records, and accounts by the contracting agency and the Secretary of Labor for purposes of investigation to ascertain compliance with such rules, regulations, and orders.
  - g) In the event of the Contractor's noncompliance with the nondiscrimination clauses of this contract or with any of such rules, regulations, or orders, this contract may be cancelled, terminated, or suspended in whole or in part and the Contractor may be declared ineligible for further Government contracts in accordance with procedures authorized in Executive Order No. 11246 of Sept. 24, 1965, and such other sanctions may be imposed and remedies invoked as provided in Executive Order No. 11246 of September 24, 1965, or by rule, regulation, or order of the Secretary of Labor, or as otherwise provided by law.
  - h) The Contractor will include the provisions of paragraphs (a) through (h) in every subcontract or purchase order unless exempted by rules, regulations, or orders of the Secretary of Labor issued pursuant to Section 204 of Executive Order No. 11246 of September 24, 1965, so that such provisions will be binding upon each Subcontractor or Contractor. The Contractor will take such action with respect to any subcontract or purchase order as may be directed by the Secretary of Labor as a means of enforcing such provisions including sanctions for noncompliance: Provided, however, that in the event the Contractor becomes involved in, or is threatened with, litigation with a Subcontractor or Contractor as a result of such direction, the Contractor may request the United States to enter into such litigation to protect the interests of the United States.
9. **Copeland "Anti-Kickback" Act (18 U.S.C. 874 and 40 U.S.C. 276C)**: The Contractor certifies that it is, and will continue to be, for the term of this contract in for compliance with the Copeland "Anti-Kickback" Act (40 U.S.C. 3145), as supplemented by Department of Labor regulations (29 CFR Part 3, "Contractors and Subcontractors on Public Building or Public Work Financed in Whole or in Part by Loans or Grants from the United States"). The Act provides that each Contractor or sub recipient must be prohibited from inducing, by any means, any person employed in the construction, completion, or repair of public work, to give up any part of the compensation to which he or she is otherwise entitled. The non-Federal entity must report all suspected or reported violations to the Federal awarding agency.
10. **Davis-Bacon Act, as Amended (40 U.S.C. 276a to A-7)**: Contractor, certifies that it is, and will continue for the term of this contract, to comply with the Davis-Bacon Act (40 U.S.C. 3141-3144, and 3146- 3148) as supplemented by Department of Labor regulations (29 CFR Part 5, "Labor Standards Provisions Applicable to Contracts Covering Federally Financed and Assisted Construction"). In accordance with the statute, the Contractor is herein required to pay wages to laborers and mechanics at a rate not less than the prevailing wages specified in a wage determination made by the Secretary of Labor. In addition, Contractor agrees to pay

wages not less than once a week. The Contractor must provide a copy of the current prevailing wage determination issued by the Department of Labor in each solicitation. Contractor acknowledges that the decision to award this contract or subcontract is conditioned upon the acceptance of the wage determination which the Contractor accepts. The Contractor agrees to report all suspected or reported violations to the Federal awarding agency and to notify the District concurrently. The Contractor certifies that it is, and will continue to be, for the term of this contract in full compliance with the Copeland "Anti-Kickback" Act (40 U.S.C. 3145), as supplemented by Department of Labor regulations (29 CFR Part 3, "Contractors and Subcontractors on Public Building or Public Work Financed in Whole or in Part by Loans or Grants from the United States"). The Act provides that each Contractor or sub recipient must be prohibited from inducing, by any means, any person employed in the construction, completion, or repair of public work, to give up any part of the compensation to which he or she is otherwise entitled. The non-Federal entity must report all suspected or reported violations to the Federal awarding agency.

11. **Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act (40 U.S.C. 327-333):** Contractor, certifies that it is, and will continue for the term of this contract, to comply with 40 U.S.C. 3702 and 3704, as supplemented by Department of Labor regulations (29 CFR Part 5). Under 40 U.S.C. 3702 of the Act, each Contractor must be required to compute the wages of every mechanic and laborer on the basis of a standard work week of 40 hours. Work in excess of the standard work week is permissible provided that the worker is compensated at a rate of not less than one and a half times the basic rate of pay for all hours worked in excess of 40 hours in the work week. The requirements of 40 U.S.C. 3704 are applicable to construction work and provide that no laborer or mechanic must be required to work in surroundings or under working conditions which are unsanitary, hazardous or dangerous. These requirements do not apply to the purchases of supplies or materials or articles ordinarily available on the open market, or contracts for transportation or transmission of intelligence.
12. **Health and Safety Standards in Building Trades and Construction Industry (40 U.S.C. 3704):** No laborer or mechanic must be required to work in surroundings or under working conditions which are unsanitary, hazardous, or dangerous.
