Recommended Action	Approval to piggyback Orange County Public Schools ITB No. 2208262, for Lock and Door Hardware, awarded to Electronic Access Specialists, Inc. d/b/a Southern Lock and Supply, Inc., in Largo, FL, Independent Hardware South, Inc., in Philadelphia, PA, and Shankle, LLC d/b/a Ilock, in Orlando, FL, for the period of November 16, 2024 through November 15, 2025, for up to \$350,000.00, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District. Approval authorizes the Superintendent to execute all related documents.

Orange County Public Schools ITB No. 2208262, for Lock and Door Hardware, was awarded to Electronic Access Specialists, Inc. d/b/a Southern Lock and Supply, Inc., in Largo, FL, Independent Hardware South, Inc., in Philadelphia, PA, and Shankle, LLC d/b/a Ilock, in Orlando, FL, for the period of November 15, 2022 through November 15, 2023, with anticipated renewal through November 15, 2025. This piggyback will be utilized by the Infrastructure Services Department and Maintenance Services Department to purchase locks, exit devices, and access control hardware and equipment at a discounted price.

It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$350,000.00, for the period of November 16, 2024 through November 15, 2025, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
