Budget Source	Up to \$13,739,366.00 will be funded from budgeted Infrastructure Services and Maintenance Services Department funds. This agenda item is specifically for the approval of the piggyback. Funds will only be expended within the existing resources of the applicable locations.
Recommended Action	Approval to piggyback Orange County Public Schools ITB No. 2208262, for Lock and Door Hardware, awarded to Multiple Vendors including Electronic Access Specialists, Inc. d/b/a Southern Lock and Supply, Inc., in Largo, FL, for the period of November 16, 2025 through November 15, 2026, for up to \$13,739,366.00, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District. Approval authorizes the Superintendent to execute all related documents.

Orange County Public Schools ITB No. 2208262, for Lock and Door Hardware, was awarded to multiple vendors including Electronic Access Specialists, Inc. d/b/a Southern Lock and Supply, Inc., in Largo, FL, for the period of November 15, 2022 through November 16, 2023 and renewed through November 15, 2026. This contract will be utilized by the Infrastructure Services Department and Maintenance Services Department to purchase locks, exit devices, and access control hardware and equipment at a discounted price. The anticipated projects include, but are not limited to:

- \$1,890,000.00 – Cape Coral High School (Capital Project Fund)
- \$1,890,000.00 – Diplomat Elementary School (Capital Project Fund)
- \$1,890,000.00 – Dunbar High School (Capital Project Fund)
- \$1,890,000.00 – Estero High School (Capital Project Fund)
- \$1,502,366.00 – Three Oaks Middle School (Capital Project Fund)
- \$1,400,000.00 – Gulf Middle School (Capital Project Fund)
- \$1,260,000.00 – Pinewoods Elementary School (Capital Project Fund)
- \$1,057,000.00 – Day to Day (Capital Project Fund)
- \$960,000.00 – Lee County Public Education Center (Capital Project Fund)

It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$13,739,366.00, for the period of November 16, 2025 through November 15, 2026, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
