Budget Source	Up to \$650,000.00 will be funded from budgeted Maintenance Services Department funds. This agenda item is specifically for the approval of the expenditures. Funds will only be expended within the existing resources of the applicable location.
Recommended Action	Approval of expenditure for ITN No. N247471MG for Concrete Finishing & Block Work, awarded to American Management Resources Corporation (AMRC), in Fort Myers, FL and Pavement Maintenance, LLC, in Fort Myers, FL, for up to \$650,000.00, for the third year of the base contract period of March 27, 2026 through March 26, 2027, pursuant to the same terms and conditions as previously approved by the Board. Approval authorizes the Superintendent to execute all related documents.

Invitation to Negotiate No. N247471MG is for Concrete Finishing & Block Work. Services include new concrete construction, improvement projects, patching and repair of existing concrete, and block work. Concrete work will include, but is not limited to, footers, sidewalks, walkways, structural slabs, slab on grade, and play courts at various locations throughout the District. On January 23, 2024, this ITN was awarded to American Management Resources Corporation (AMRC), in Fort Myers, FL and Pavement Maintenance, LLC, in Fort Myers, FL, for a three-year period, beginning March 27, 2024 through March 26, 2027, with renewal options for three additional one-year periods, upon the written agreement of the vendors and the District.

It is recommended the Board approve up to \$650,000.00, for the third year of the base contract period of March 27, 2026 through March 26, 2027, pursuant to the same terms and conditions as previously approved by the Board.
