Recommended Action	Approval to piggyback Sourcewell - RFP #091422, for Facility MRO, Industrial, and Building-Related Supplies and Equipment, awarded to Fastenal Company with locations in Fort Myers, FL, for the period of November 9, 2024 through November 8, 2025, for up to \$2,200,000.00, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District. Approval authorizes the Superintendent to execute all related documents.

Sourcewell - RFP #091422, for Facility MRO, Industrial, and Building-Related Supplies and Equipment, was awarded to Fastenal Company with locations in Fort Myers, FL, for the period of November 30, 2022 through November 8, 2026 with renewal options of two additional one-year periods. This contract supports the ability to purchase Maintenance Repair Operation (MRO) products at discounted prices. Examples of available products include electrical (fans, ballasts, batteries, battery packs, lamps, etc.), plumbing (fixtures, water heaters, etc.), and HVAC parts (motors for fans and compressors, etc.). It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$2,200,000.00, for the period of November 9, 2024 through November 8, 2025, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
