Budget Source	Up to \$4,163,286.85 will be funded from budgeted School/Department funds. This agenda item is specifically for the approval of the award. Funds will only be expended within the existing resources of the applicable location.
Recommended Action	Approval to award ITN No. N257512DO for E-Rate Network Infrastructure Equipment, to CDW Government, LLC, in Vernon Hills, IL, as indicated on the attached tabulation sheet. This ITN will be effective for three years, beginning February 27, 2026 through February 26, 2029, with renewal options for two additional one-year periods, upon the written agreement of the vendor and the District, for up to \$4,163,286.85, for the first year of the base contract period of February 27, 2026 through February 26, 2027. Approval authorizes the Superintendent to execute all related documents.

Invitation to Negotiate No. N257512DO is for E-Rate Network Infrastructure Equipment. This ITN enables the District to maintain compliance with the federal E-Rate program guidelines as established by the Universal Service Administrative Company's Schools and Libraries Division (USAC/SLD) for Category 2 (Internal Connections) equipment. It is estimated that the District will receive discounts, through the E-Rate program, for approximately 85% of the purchases made utilizing this contract. Eighty-one (81) vendors were notified of the ITN, five (5) vendors submitted a Proposal, zero (0) vendors submitted a No Bid and seventy-five (75) vendors did not respond.
