| Recommended Action | Approval of expenditure for ITN No. N227423DO for Fuel Pump - Maintenance, Repair and Replacement, awarded to Southern Tank and Pump Co., in North Fort Myers, FL, for up to \$275,000.00, for the third year of the base contract period of December 6, 2024 through December 5, 2025, pursuant to the same terms and conditions as previously approved by the Board. Approval authorizes the Superintendent to execute all related documents. |

Invitation to Negotiate No. N227423DO is for Fuel Pump - Maintenance, Repair and Replacement. Services and products support the maintenance, repair and replacement of fuel pumps throughout the District. This ITN also supports the purchase of RNI/FuelOmat Fuel Rings, which provide access for buses and white fleet vehicles to utilize the District's fuel pumps. On December 6, 2022, this ITN was awarded to Southern Tank and Pump Co., in North Fort Myers, FL, for a three-year period, beginning December 6, 2022 through December 5, 2025, with renewal options for three additional one-year periods, upon the written agreement of the vendor and the District. It is recommended the Board approve up to \$275,000.00, for the third year of the base contract period of December 6, 2024 through December 5, 2025, pursuant to the same terms and conditions as previously approved by the Board.
