## Public Content

Lee County Board of County Commissioners ITB No. B230548WCD, for Athletic Turf Maintenance and Reconstruction, was awarded to JSM Services, Inc. in Fort Myers, for the period of February 6, 2024 through February 5, 2027. This contract will allow for athletic field maintenance work including but not limited to reconstructing turf surfaces and laser-level sports fields, aerating, top dressing, fertilizing, and spraying for weeds, herbicides, pesticides, etc. The anticipated projects include, but are not limited to:

- \$91,644.00 - Mariner High School: 8.5 Acres of Athletic Field Maintenance (General Funds)
- \$88,949.00 - Lehigh Senior High School: 8.25 Acres of Athletic Field Maintenance (General Funds)
